

Propane Tank Out of Date?

Let us help!

Tennessee State Law prohibits us from filling propane tanks that are out of date or damaged. Out of date tanks are over 12 years old or haven't been re-certified in the past 5 years.

We really don't like refusing to fill your propane tank. If that is necessary, we will help by offering \$15 OFF on the purchase of a NEW propane tank with a refill. We would be happy to dispose of your old tank, too, at no cost.

To check the date on your tank, look for 4 numbers stamped on the tank's collar (Example - 12 13). The first two numbers are the month and the last two numbers are the year that your propane tank was manufactured.

To determine a tank's expiration date, add 12 years to the tank date. For example, a tank stamped with a date of 12 01 would expire on December 31, 2013; and a tank stamped with a date of 01 02 would expire on January 31, 2014.
